



Player / Official / Supporter / Parent Code of Conduct

Any Player / Spectator / Coach / Parent or Official present at a match or otherwise involved in any activity staged or sanctioned by CCF or Kincumber Roos FC must at all times:

Conduct yourself in a manner that enhances the reputation and goodwill of football on the Central Coast.

Respect the decisions of match officials and teach children to do the same.

Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, race, colour, religion, language, politics, national, or ethnic origin.

Not engage in discrimination, harassment, intimidation or abuse in any form, including the use of obscene or offensive language or gestures, the incitement of hatred or violence or partaking in indecent or racist chanting.

Not use violence in any form, whether it is against other spectators, Team Officials (including coaches) Match Officials or Players.

Never ridicule or unduly scold a child for making a mistake - positive comments are motivational, negative comments are harmful.

Abide by Kincumber Roos FC constitution and By-Laws.

Any Person who does not comply with this Code of Behaviour / conduct or who otherwise causes a disturbance may be evicted from a venue and banned from attending future matches.

In the event of necessary action – you will be asked to attend an Internal Club Judiciary hearing to explain your actions and face further suspensions or fines to be determined at the hearing.
